WELCOME TO HOLA MUNDO BEACH CAMP!

Thank you for choosing Hola Mundo Beach Camp for your child's summer camp experience. We are looking forward to another terrific summer with lots of fun and exciting activities and special events.

Preparing for camp is very important which is why we try to make it easier for you. Below you will find all of the information you will need to prepare for camp.

LOCATION

Our exact location in Pompano is Pavilion 2. Pavilion 2 is located North of the Pompano Beach Pier. North of the Beach House Pompano Restaurant. (310 North Pompano Beach Boulevard).

CAMP RASHGUARD/T-Shirt

Every camper must attend camp wearing his/her camp Rashguard. This is a requirement for admittance to camp. Rashguards (\$30) and T-Shirts (\$15) are available for purchase at Camp.

If you would like to purchase your camper or CIT Rashguard and T-shirt prior to the start of camp, you may stop by our Camp's office from 3:00 pm-6:00 pm Mon-Fri or call to make an appointment during the weekend. WATER BOTTLE

Water fountains and/or coolers are available at the beach, but campers *must* bring their own sports water jug each day! Campers may NOT be dropped off if he/she does not have a water jug.

SUN SCREEN

Please apply sunscreen to your child before dropping off to camp. We stop to reapply at the beginning of every activity.

DAILY COMMUNICATION

You may communicate at all times via group text with your Counselor Leader of your group (wearing yellow t-shirts). They will send create a group text. You may also reach our Camp Director Adriana Chambliss at 754-235-0995, or Nina Carpio at 954-871-8525. ALL GENERAL CAMP COMMUNICATION will be done through the application called REMIND.

SETTING UP REMIND APP

EXCUSE FROM ACTIVITIES

We encourage your child to participate in every activity. A written note from the parent is required if the child is to be excused from participation.

<u>Drop-off:</u> Early drop off starts at 8:00 am. You have the option of using the drop-off procedure where counselors will help your child/children from your car and then escort them safely to their group, or, you may park in a **DESIGNATED PARKING SPOT** and walk them to their group yourself. Morning drop-off begins at 8:30 am, and stops promptly at 9:00 am.

<u>Pick-up:</u> 2:00 pm for afternoon pick-up please line up cars in single file. YOU DO NOT NEED TO GET OUT OF YOUR CAR! Counselors will go to your car, and then locate your children at their group's meeting point. To ensure everyone's safety, please obey the counselors directing traffic ~

they will let the other counselors know when it is safe to take the children to their cars.

There will be an extra charge for late pick up at \$1 per minute after 2:05 pm.

RAINY DAYS

During thunderstorms campers will go to the covered parking garage where counselors will engage them in a variety of activities until it is all clear. If there is heavy rain, thunder OR lighting, we will send a group text thought REMIND APP to all parents to come pick up their children. Please do not pick up your child if you have not received a group text, or a phone call from your counselor/leader, or our Director. If the rain is light, activities will continue as normal.

CHANGING TO DRY CLOTHES:

Due to our fun filled and busy schedule, your child will <u>not</u> have time to change into dry clothes at pick up. Your child will be wearing his/her dry camp t-shirt with their shorts.

LUNCH (you may pack lunch and snack everyday)

Friday: Pizza and a cookie \$10

If you would like to order lunch, buy ice cream, or request that your child ride the Banana Boat, you must send, the day of with your camper the fees. Please indicate your child's full name and order. **Ex. Mary**Miller...\$30 banana boat.

WHAT TO BRING EVERY DAY TO CAMP

- Backpack (to carry personal belongings to Camp)
- Sunscreen
- Clothes suitable for beach wear shorts, bathing suit, camp rash guard, bathing suit under clothes (girls)
- Shoes: Please, please flip flops, or slip on sandals for the beach NO SNEAKERS or closed toes shoes (remember that we walk to the beach, pier, splash pad, playground everyday)
- Towel

- Hat or visor
- Sports Water jug (label with your name!)
- Goggles
- Socks in case sand is hot to play sports or games)
- Snacks
- \$5 for Kilwins Ice Cream (TUESDAY and FRIDAY)
 CASH PLEASE
- TUESDAY and FRIDAY: bring a white t-shirt or a white clothing item for Tie Dye.
- THURSDAY Fishing Rod (if you camper likes fishing). Camp buys the bait.
- Water squirt for the younger campers (label please).
- \$30 for Banana Boat ride CASH PLEASE
